About St. Andrew's United Methodist Church Scholarship

Our vision is to provide an opportunity for a high school senior to pursue further education, develop talents and give back to the community.

This is an academic scholarship, designed for a graduating senior who has been accepted at an institution of higher learning. This can be a community college as well as a 4-year institution. Financial need, community service and leadership qualities will be strong considerations.

Selection Criteria

A committee made up of church members will select the scholarship recipient based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- Statement of financial need
- Quality of essay and recommendations
- Community service and leadership background
- Member of local community or St. Andrew's UMC Church
- Submission of all application packet components

Essay

This is a personal essay, 1 to 3 pages double-spaced. Please tell us about your long-range goals and thoughts about potential careers. Include some characteristics about yourself that you feel will help you succeed in higher education and why you want to go to college. Write about activities you have been involved in such as employment, leadership roles, community service and church. Other information to add if relevant: any accomplishments or awards in which you take pride; any challenges you have faced and how you have responded to them; financial hardships you face; any additional information that would help the selection committee.

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation are required, one from a teacher, adviser or counselor and one from a work or volunteer supervisor, youth leader or adult acquaintance. All letters should be signed and dated. Photocopies are acceptable. See the enclosed Recommendation Form to give to your references to help them in writing the letters.

Statement of Financial Need

On a separate sheet, please indicate the estimated annual cost of attending your college of choice, including tuition, fees, room and board, transportation, books, etc. List any grants or scholarships you have already received for the upcoming academic year. Please also describe any special circumstances that affect your family's ability to pay for college. These may include medical expenses,

unemployment, single head of household, etc. If you have filled out the FAFSA form and would like to include any part of that form which might help the committee, feel free to do that. It is not a requirement.

Application Procedures

1. Pick up an application at the church or download the application from our website at www.standrewsumcpaloalto.org
2. Submit the application no later than 4 PM on May 28, 2010. All transcripts, letters of recommendation and student essays are due by the deadline. No late or incomplete applications will be considered.
3. Award notification will be sent out the end of July, 2010.

Award Disbursement

A check will be issued either directly to the student recipient or directly to the school of choice, depending on the preference of the award recipient.
